In the past few months we have made some signs and printed some banners. Screen-printed some electronic gizmos and flown some flags. We have made full colour hoarding panels and produced some badges. Chemically etched stainless steel plaques and

brass nameplates. Used hardwood and softwood in the production of tabletops and made a particularly beautiful sign for an Indian restaurant (in Stainless steel with blue LED's). Vehicles have had liveries and we have partially wrapped a mini in a large insect nest, at least that's what I think it was... We have manufactured

large metal frames for some beautiful mosaics, which were mounted on the wall of a NHS clinic in Southampton. The Monolith signs we have made have been tall and wide and at least one of them has had some 3D tablets mounted on the face. A number of pavement signs were produced, of which at least 10 were made for Monkey World. Very large digital prints

have been run off for promotional purposes, some of these were used as exhibition panels. Companies have had their existing brand identity spruced up and new clients have discovered how important it is to be branded well. That is always very rewarding. However we are still waiting for the job that makes itself and lasts forever, I won't be holding my breath. On a slightly different note Graham
